Mrs. McDevitt read Father’s speech from his speech book #34, titled “The Path We Take,” given on June 9, 1970.

“We have 387 nations (194 Abel nations and 193 Cain nations) in the world. All these countries must have one tradition.”

“Vertically and horizontally there is only one center. If man and woman don’t have the center for them to be united, they don’t have to exist.

“The most important thing in the world is that there is the incorporeal center in the middle.”

Yeong In Che (spirit self) is my original term. In any other religion, they say? (Hon: soul / spirit).”

“The Korean language is epiphanic. (For example) Jugeum (death) is shinu’ in Japanese. Shinu corresponds to shinoo in Korean which is the same as ___ meaning sister-in-law. There is a meaning why these two words are the same in pronunciation.”
