Mrs. Yang read Father’s speech given on January 3, 1970, titled “Jesus’ Birth and Our Mission.”

“In Nigeria, I said three things (to the president): blood lineage, tradition, and harmony. By blood, one resembles another.”

“Among sun light, water, air and soil, what is most important? Sunlight.”

“Without absolute love, that is, true love, one cannot be united with each other. Your eyes, nose, hair and all were born for true love and they do not complain.”

“Kamiyama! You divided Japan(ese movement) into two groups and you do not know how much I have to work to (solve) that (problem).”

“The settlement of the True Parents of Heaven, Earth, Humankind. Proclamation of the Substantial Word of God. Cosmic Assembly.”

“Recently, I said Won Mo. It means ‘uterus.’ (‘Won Mo Peace and Love Foundation,’ which Father established recently) represents the entire cosmos.”
