“140,000 years ago, humans came to use symbols to communicate, and alphabets came after that.”

“My sister-in-law died young, about 27 or 28 years old, due to cancer. Do you know who she was? I said to her that my brother, my parents and grandparents listened to me and so she must do so too, and she discussed things with me.”

“Jang Bo Go: 788 — 841 had a heavenly mission of kicking out the pirates from Shilla territory, who was one of my ancestors. I will bring back to Korea the body of Joon Lee (a Korean diplomat who died in Hague, Netherlands in 1907 during his activities against Japanese imperialism). I have to be responsible for the history of Ahn Joong Geun: 1879 – 1910)*.”

Note:

* Ahn Joong Geun (September 2, 1879 – March 26, 1910) was a Korean independence activist, nationalist, Christian, and pan-Asianist. On October 26, 1909, he assassinated Hirobumi Ito, the first Prime Minister of Japan and then-Japanese Resident-General of Korea, following the signing of the Eulsa Treaty (Japan’s annexation of Korea).
