The MC was just standing at the podium to welcome everyone when electricity returned. A respected local religious leader gave the welcoming address to participants, followed by Rev. Kwak's introductory message read by a local member leader. It was amazing to hear participants applauding many times during speech, a sign of the importance of the content.
