Report from Austria: Two Years of Principle Work in Austria
On May 18, 1965 I arrived in Vienna to begin to proclaim the Divine Principle in
Austria. I had left my family in Wiesbaden, to be able to do the utmost for the
mission. For the first four months my VW-Bus was the Headquarters in Austria,
in which I slept, lived, and taught. I taught wherever possible, but the first year
went by with little visible success. The second year was a blessing for Austria.
Our Association was recognized by the Austrian Government and registered on
May 16, 1966. Now Austria has a very strong Principle Family. In our large
Headquarters eight people are living together. The second Center in Vienna is
occupied by four persons, and others will move in. Some live in private quarters.
In addition there are also some less active members.

Austria has now three cities that have Centers -- Vienna, Graz, and Linz. In Vienna public sermons are given Sunday and Tuesday evenings, in which Divine Principle is being taught. More than seventy such public meetings have been held to date. Many invitations to our activities have been handed out. At Headquarters missionaries are being trained steadily. Eleven of our missionaries have already given public sermons.

Special weight has been put upon personal development, based on divine love and truth, and so the Austrian Family is a solid and strong family.

We are all in anticipation of the coming of our Parents and their party and preparations are being made both spiritually and physically as much as possible. May we

all be prepared, so that we can bring joy to our Father and our True Parents. Love in their Name, your brother, Paul.

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London, England

Dear Miss Kim: I am presently in the hospital -- St. Stephen's in Fulham. This is my 4th day. I knew eventually I would have to go to the hospital, but I knew I had to accomplish certain things first. Friday night I lectured to the two people (Mrs. Bidgood and Mr. Pegram) who came all the way from Rhodesia and South Africa to hear the Principle. The pain stopped wonderfully while I lectured to them. It brought me such joy to lecture and teach. I thought to myself, even if I only had four hours to live, I would like to spend them in this way. The next day I prolonged seeing the doctor half a day so we could by a twelve-seat mini-bus. (Which we will use when Father and Mother eventually come to this country or give to Peter to use if they only go to Germany.) Finally I went to the doctor and next day I was in the hospital. I am 100% better now and will go home tomorrow. (The doctor came by as I was writing and said that I must wait yet another day more.)

Reiner arrived from France last night! He did not know my condition, but had been praying on the Paris Holy Ground when he suddenly knew he <u>must</u> urgently go to England. So he left immediately!

Because of my illness, some things in our small English Family were falling apart. Reiner has done so many wonderful things since he came last night, and has helped me immensely. He leaves tomorrow night.

Living in the Centre is Don, David, June, myself, and Eve. The women are very strong. Eve is now also teaching. June will establish the second London Centre on 20 July in the infamous East End, where dwell the cockneys. June teaches school in the East End and really loves the cockneys. She has been preparing intensely to go there. She took the test last weekend. She will go alone. I know she will be all right and will do well.

Eve's sister, Patricia, (a nurse), will move into the Centre 31 July. She is a completely different personality from Eve, but will become equally as strong. She wants to quickly begin teaching. Also, Anna Roncaglia from the Rome Centre has come to England and wants to live with me. Living outside the Centre is Rennie, a Jamaican, and Charles. Many are studying with us: two cockneys (one Church of England and one a Druid!): Eve is teaching the Druid. The two South Africans will finish the whole lecture series before they return. I have two people who want to take the correspondence course, but they must wait until Sylvia sends me the ordered manuscripts, for I have not one left.

So, that is superficially the situation in England. Anthony has not contacted me since the first meeting, but Monica Parrish wants to study the Principle through correspondence. I don't know about these people. If they approach me in an outwardly positive way, I cannot be rude, for that will only cause greater problems. I will just do what I feel is best, step by step. My main work now is to strengthen and deepen Don, David, June, Eve, Patricia -- making them good teachers and leaders. At the same time, we look for new people.

I received Peter's copy of your letter, and I realized that our Leader would not come to Europe. I was in the hospital when I read Peter's letter. All I felt like doing was crying. I know we in Europe are perhaps not 100% ready for his visit, but the anticipation in our hearts had built up so very much -- I just felt terrible.

Because you gave so much of yourself in those eighty days in England, you can perhaps understand how easily one can love this city and England. Though the English are so difficult and stubborn, there is something so wonderfully appealing about them. There is great variety within this so small a country. The Englishman cannot be simply described, because there are so many different kinds of Englishmen. There is a strange, indefinable thing that seems to permeate all the the English, but I cannot say exactly what it is. They are strong and deep, having unseen resources lying deep within themselves. They are not easy to always understand.

I feel as if I now understand the English, but I will not be able to ever portray this understanding in words. I am too close to them now. They are a part of me. My greatest sorrow is that I have not yet found a quantity of these reluctant English to be with our Leader and Mother when the eventually come to Europe. Looking around at the small number that we are in London, I feel as if I have done nothing in eighteen months.

I cannot believe he is not coming to Europe. All of Europe, even <u>outside</u> the Principle, is preparing for him! In London they are sand-cleaning <u>all</u> the important buildings and making everything shiny and clean. Directly across from the Holy Ground, they have built a beautiful new hotel called THE <u>ROYAL</u> LANCASTER. It overlooks the Holy Ground, Kensington Gardens, and Hyde Park.

All the important Underground Stations (Lancaster Gate, Green Park, Gloucester Road) have been rebuilt and repainted. And now London Transport is doing the same thing at other stations. London is cleaning herself and making all things new for his coming. As I told you, we bought a twelve-seat bus for his coming. We dedicated it on Sunday, the day after I was released from the hospital. It is a grey and white Austin with red seats and white walls inside. It really is a happy little bus!

Greetings, dear Family, from Washington! Washington has been the scene of much varied activity -- both physical and spiritual. With twenty people in a center, we are learning not only the joy of sharing our lives, but also the responsibilities we each must take to make a center run smoothly and conserve the maximum amount of time to "be about our Father's business."

Miss Kim has been stressing the importance of our using every moment wisely and purposefully, pointing out that although we may be working hard, it is possible to be doing it only for ourselves. Therefore it is our attitude and purpose which determines how much work we are doing for Father.

As we see more and more people coming to be taught, we realize the necessity for each of us to prepare for leadership responsibilities — to incorporate a high standard within ourselves. The Case Against Reincarnation

To get the right answers to your questions, consult someone who has already had that particular experience. This is just as true for the spiritual as it is for the material world. No one should know better whther or not the soul returns to earth after ''death'' to inhabit another physical body than those who have already passed through this change, those who are now in the world of spirit.

So it was with great interest that I first heard a spirit entity questioned about reincarnation. This was many years ago at a trumpet seance in San Francisco. "Tell us, Dr. Briggs, is there such a thing as reincarnation? Does the soul return to this earth or to any other planet to inhabit a new flesh body?"

"As you know," Dr. Briggs' deep, scholarly voice shook the walls of that darkened room, "I have been here a long time by earth count, and to my knowledge there is no reincarnation. I have never known of anyone returning to any earth plane to activate a new flesh body." He continued, "Nor have I spoken to anyone on this side of life who had more than one physical earth life."

Dr. Briggs is the wise teacher-guide of one of the foremost mediums in this country. She has been the pastor of the largest spiritualist church in this area for over fifty ye ars and is widely acclaimed for both her amazing ability as a clair-voyant and for her honesty and integrity. Through years of study and insight, she learned to test the veracity of those spirits who contact us through her gift. She brooks no frauds.

Dr. Briggs' pronouncement was but one more piece of evidence against the theosophy of reincarnation. The belief that we are trapped again and again within a flesh body, blindly to make the same mistake over and over, is unthinkable. No earthly father would condemn his children to so cruel a fate, then how much less would our loving Heavenly Father so condemn us? All evidence clearly shows that reincarnation is not God's Great Plan for His children.

Many of my friends believed in reincarnation. Most do no longer. But their efforts to convert me to their way of thinking drove me to arm myself against their attacks. Much authoritative ammunition is found scattered throughout the Bible. Heavy artillery was mustered through psychic study: books, developmental classes, hours of meditative research and prayer and direct contact with those in spirit. This direct contact furnished the strongest armament of all.

Recently a master teacher from spirit honored me with his help. As Ori Hanji, (phonetic spelling), he was born in India, close to the Tibetan border. My first question was, "When you were in the physical form of life, did you believe in reincarnation?"

"Yes, but I have learned better," he answered.

"Then you no longer expect to return to this earth or to any other in a new flesh body?" I persisted.

"No, I do not. The purpose of life is progression, to grow toward God. Continually repeating the same earthly existence over and over with no knowledge left to correct former mistakes is as cruel as blinding a slave and condemning him to a treadmill. He goes round and round until one day, by pure chance, he stumbles off his wheel and miraculously regains his sight."

The purpose of life is progression, to grow toward God. Continuous progression is based upon continuous learning. What we learn on earth we retain as a foundation for the studies we do after we shed this physical body. We continue onward and upward.

For those who believe in reincarnation, progression stops when they reach the spirit world. As Dr. Briggs explained, "I have seen many spirits just sitting and waiting to re-enter new flesh bodies. All efforts to lead these misguided souls to the Great Halls of Learning are in vain. They cripple their own advancement, they stunt their own growth by their stubbornness. Those who taught them this philosophy have much to answer for."

One of these repentant prophets is Madame Helena P. Blavatsky, whose teachings and writings made world-wide the theory of reincarnation. She now admits that she was wrong in a seance conducted by Dr. Carl A. Wickland, M.D., through the mediumship of Mrs. Wickland.

"I wanted to be a leader in some way or other. Now I want to bring the truth to the world. I knew of spirit manifestations, for I had them myself. I did a great deal in my early days along this line, but then I commenced to investigate theosophy. To me came reincarnation. It appealed to me for a time, for I could not see Truth clearly....I studied reincarnation, and I thought there was truth and justice in the theory that we come back and learn and have more experiences. I taught it and wanted to bring it out to the world and its peoples. I felt that I remembered far back in my past. I felt that I knew all about my past, but I was mistaken."

This memory of past lives is the strongest and only argument the reincarnationists have. Now Madame Blavatsky explains what these "memories" are. "Memories of past lives are caused by spirits that bring such thoughts and represent the lives they lived. A spirit impresses you with the experiences of its life and these are implanted in your mind as your own. You then think that you remember your past. I took it for granted that these memories were true, but when I came to the spirit side of life, I learned differently."

Reincarnationists believe that the soul returns to earth, housed in new flesh, to correct former mistakes and to right former wrongs. This is a commendable idea, except that the reincarnated soul is left with but vague impressions of former lives and learning. All clear-cut knowledge is erased from the mind. How, then, can you know what mistakes to correct or what wrongs to right?

Would you permit a teacher to demote your child to a lower grade in school so that the child learns his lessons better, but at the same time wipe his mind clean of all former learning? Of course you would not! That is cruel.

God is stern, God is just, God is even angry at times. But God is never, never cruel. Throughout the Bible are examples of the kindness of God, the love of God, the mercy of God.

The Lord hath appeared of old unto me saying, 'Yes, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with loving kindness have I drawn thee.

Jeremiah 31:3

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believeth in him should not perish but have everlasting life.

John 3:16

I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed thee.

Isaiah 44:22

No one who believes in the Bible can believe in reincarnation. There are too many unequivocal statements which refute it.

Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it. Ecclesiastes 12:7

If reincarnation is the way of life, then spirits cannot return to warn and guide us. Yet the Bible contains many examples of communication with those who left the earth plane hundreds of years before their reappearance as spirits. The classic example is the conference held at the Mount of Transfiguration: "And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus." (Mark 9:4) The Bible contains but one quote which the reincarnationists are able to twist to their own misinterpretation: "Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord:..." (Malachi 4:5) A reincarnated Elijah in the body of John the Baptist, with but flashes and vague impressions of his former knowledge would be of little use in God's Great Plan. How much more effective would the spirit of Elijah be with all his earthly and heavenly wisdom, to guide and counsel John.

Even the words, reincarnate, reincarnated, reincarnation are not in the Bible. Born again and live again are, but from the context mean a renewal of spirit or to be born into the spirit world. If reincarnation were true, Jesus, hanging on His cross on that terrible day of crucifixion, would not have told the repentant thief, "Verily I say unto thee. Today shalt thou be with me in Paradise." (Luke 23:43) No, he would have said, "As soon as your spirit is free from your body, go quickly, find a woman about to give birth to a child and take up your new body."

Spirit entities, with a strong belief in reincarnation while on this earth, do exactly that. They usurp another soul's domain. The results are misery and unhappiness for all concerned and lead to nothing but confusion and often to insanity. Dr. Carl A. Wickland, M.D. explains the great damage done by these marauding spirits in his book, My Thirty Years Among the Dead.*

Death does not make a saint out of a sinner, nor a sage of a fool. The mentality is the same as before, and individuals carry with them their old desires, habits, dogmas, faulty teachings, indifference or disbelief in a future state.

Assuming forms which are the result of their thought life on earth, millions remain for a time in the earth sphere and often in the environment of their earth lives, still held by their habits or interests.

Lacking physical bodies with which to carry out earthy propensities, many discarnate intelligences are attracted to the magnetic light which emanates from mortals and, consciously or unconsciously, attach themselves to these magnetic auras, finding an avenue of expression through influencing, obsessing, or possessing human beings. Such obtruding spirits influence susceptible sensitives with their thoughts, impart their own emotions to them, weaken their will-power and often control their actions, producing great distress, mental confusion and suffering.

Statistics show that insanity is increasing with alarming rapidity everywhere,

Statistics also show an alarming increase in a belief in reincarnation. Is there any correlation between the growing numbers of mentally ill and the spreading belief in reincarnation? All evidence says that there is.

If you cannot give up the idea of reincarnation at this time, at least take an open mind with you when you leave your flesh body. Take time to investigate when you arrive in the spirit world. Do not sit like a bump on a log and wait to return to the flesh. Do not be stubborn and refuse all guidance toward learning and progress.

In this your new home of the spirit the mind is all powerful, what you think is, is what will be. A too-strong determination to reincarnate leads to nothing but unhappiness and delayed spiritual growth for both you and the unsullied spark of God which is the birth-right of every new-born child.

For those who think right the spirit world is filled with beauty, music, books, old friends, loving relatives, wise teachers, peace, and satisfying work to do. So pray for the right answers, remember, "Ask and you will receive."

But, on the other hand, I have heard many times said that the reason I can go out and help my fellow man is because of my great love for God. Yes, you should have a great love for the Father; but, if you do not really love your fellow man, you do not really love the Father. People will not respond if you do not have love or concern for them. We are called the Unified Family. Our aim is to make the whole of mankind one family with the Father at the head. If we are to be a true reflection of God, and we know that He has unconditional love for all of His children, all of mankind, then we must have the same love for all of mankind. The most active kind of love we can show to all of those who have helped us to come closer to the Father is to give more and more of ourselves to the restoration; that will make them all happier than anything else we could do. That is from the Father on down the line.

I think that once a week each and every one of us should go off by himself and think, "What does it mean to be a full-time member of the Unified Family? Then think over the last week's activities and feelings and thinkings and grade ourselves. Then see what we should do the following week to improve. Pray to Father. He will show you what to do.

Vienna, Austria

Emilie Steberl

(Emmi is 35 years old and an insurance clerk.)

I was born in Slovakia and grew up together with my twin sister under quiet, orderly, simple and contented family conditions. Up to my twelfth year of life my religious education took place according to customs in a village where Protestants were a minority. Then, at the end of the war, we were evacuated to Austria. It was there that I was confirmed into the Protestant Church with the Bible passage: "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want." With great expectations we sang the song: "Now take my hands and lead me." But twenty years passed by until I recognized this guidance.

The only fulfillment in my life I saw in an occupation that would give me the opportunity to work independently with many people. This couldn't be realized however, and therefore I saw very little sense in my life, because I had no real goal. Especially during the last year, before Inge Eisner confronted me with the Principle, I kept asking myself questions as to the goal of my life. I put my hands in front of me and thought, "Why are they made like this, if I can't do any more with them in my life than I'm doing now?"

For about six weeks Paul Werner and our Principle Family tried very hard to teach me the Principle, but for a long time I couldn't grasp what it was all about.
